## REUSE OF SECONDARY RESOURCES AS A FACTOR IN THE PRODUCTION POTENTIAL GROWTH

The state of the production potential of industrial company is mainly influenced by its material resources. Effective use of resources contributes to reducing the cost of production, increasing profits and profitability allowing the company to remain competitive. Today, secondary material resources are increasingly used in order to reduce the cost of material inputs. Secondary material resources are production waste, for which there is a possibility of reuse on the territory of the Republic of Belarus [1]. The sources of secondary material resources are consumption waste and production waste. The main waste used after recycling at manufacturing companies is scrap and waste of ferrous, non-ferrous and precious metals, paper and rubber-containing waste, and others.

More than 3 million tons of waste are generated annually in the Republic of Belarus, but their reuse doesn't reach even half of the total volume. The hindering factors are imperfection of the regulatory framework; outdated processing technologies; lack of necessary equipment; lack of economic incentives. The main directions of improving the work with secondary material resources are presented in "The National Strategy for the management of solid municipal waste and secondary material resources in the Republic of Belarus for the period up to 2035". The foundational task in this sphere is to create an explicit structure or network of facilities that ensures safe and profitable waste management, using at least 50 % of the volume of their formation by 2035.
