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ANALYSIS AND DEVELOPMENT PROSPECTS OF THE JOINT DEVELOPMENT OF ANIMAL HUSBANDRY BETWEEN CHINA AND BELARUS

Summary. *Animal husbandry is an important industry for China and Belarus, and the joint development of both parties has the potential for mutual benefit and win-win results. This article analyzes the advantages of common development of China-Belarus animal husbandry industry from the aspects of current situation, development prospects, political factors, etc.*

According to China's 2023 livestock industry financial report, China's livestock industry self-sufficiency rate remains at around 85 %. The demand gap is huge. Due to its large population, China has become the world's largest importer of agricultural and livestock products. In 2021, my country's total livestock imports will reach US\$52.34 billion. Therefore, China urgently needs a stable and more affordable exporting country that uses RMB transactions.

Belarus has a developed animal husbandry industry, with a milk self-sufficiency rate of over 260 % and a meat self-sufficiency rate of 130 %. Belarus has fully ensured its own food security and sold its remaining products to foreign

markets. According to statistics, in 2020, the country produced 7.2 million tons of milk and 3.2 million tons of meat.

First of all, China and Belarus have huge potential for joint development of animal husbandry. China's dairy and meat products market has great demand. Class distribution changed from a pyramidal society to an olive-shaped society, and the demand for high-quality meat and dairy products increased. Belarus' livestock industry is very developed and meets China's needs in quantity. At the same time, the products are of high quality and meet the needs of the mid-to-high-end market in addition to the general market. The development potential is huge.

Due to the One Belt and One Road economic system, China and Belarus have extremely excellent business policies and cooperation space. The current situation of the livestock industry of the two countries is in a complementary state and can achieve a perfect balance. With the increasing cooperation and exchanges between China and Belarus, With the introduction of various mutually beneficial policies, there is now more and more cooperation between the two countries.
